



ABC Recycling, a British Columbia-based metal recycling business, proposes to construct a metal shredding and recycling facility adjacent to the Lehigh Northwest Concrete factory off of Marine Drive. This facility will process post-consumer goods (depolluted autos, compressed light iron, appliances, etc) and create recyclable shredded ferrous and non ferrous metal. The shredded ferrous metal will be transported to the ABC Recycling shipping facility at the Port of Bellingham and shipped to various steel mills to be remelted for future use such as reinforcing bar, structural shapes, hot or cold rolled coils, etc.

KEY FACTS AND FIGURES

- The facility will create 12-15 jobs at initial operations with 30 jobs anticipated at full capacity.
- The primary infeed and shredder will be located on the northern part of the site so that existing vegetation barriers will limit impacts to residential neighbors. Enclosures for the metal shredder and key downstream processing equipment should significantly mitigate potential noise and emissions.
- Anticipated truck traffic will average of 3-5 trucks an hour, subject to traffic conditions.
- Facility will operate in full compliance with all relevant Department of Ecology and Northwest Clean Air Agency requirements using state-of-the-art technology.
- Barring machine failure, the facility will be able to process all raw material stockpiled on site each day.
